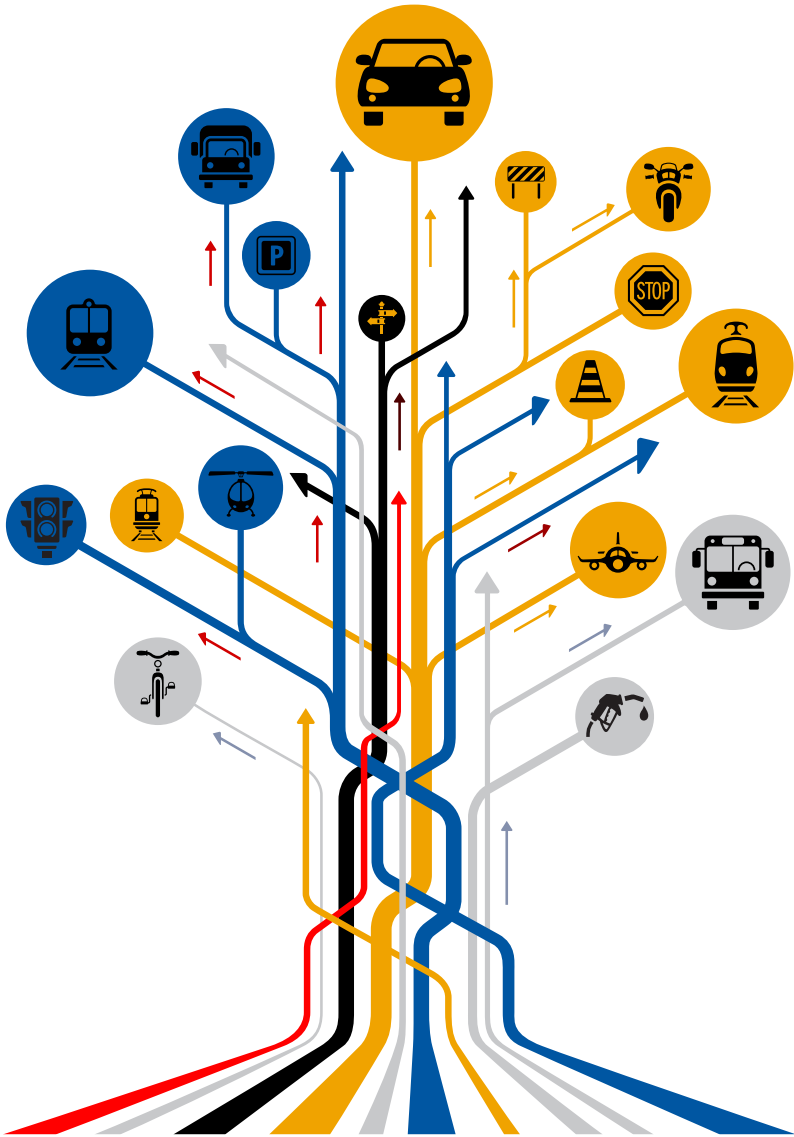
Curriculum

Students in the Master of Science in Transportation Management program take 10 classes (30 units), while certificate students take 4 classes (12 units).



Course topics include:

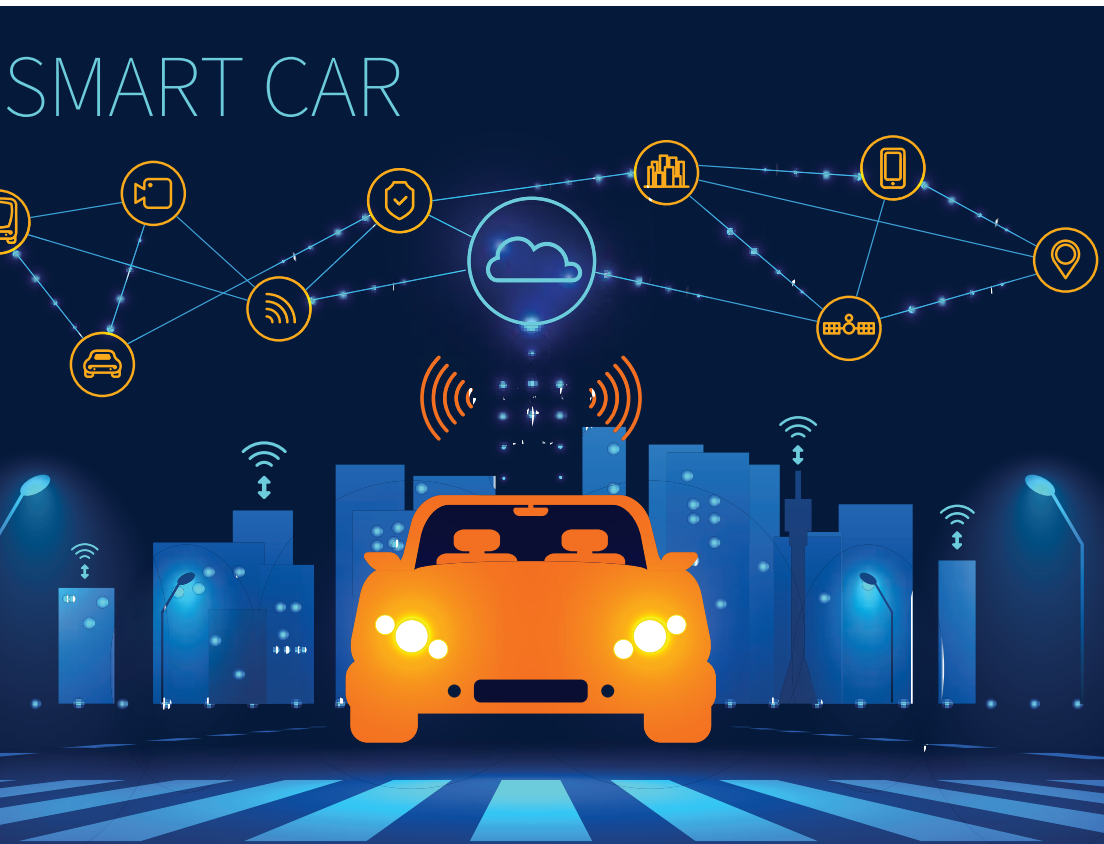
- Organizational management principles
