- → CTF was established in 1988 as a 501c3 by former Caltrans Chief Deputy Director Heinz Heckeroth
- → Simple mission: recognize, remember, educate
- → Since our founding we have awarded over \$2 million in scholarships





## RECOGNIZE





CTF honors excellence in transportation at the annual CTF Transportation Awards ceremony, where top honors in 18 different categories are awarded each year.

## REMEMBER



Since 2021 CTF has provided support to the families of 32 fallen transportation workers

  - Close typically
     November/December

- Meet the criteria
  - Included all attachments
  - Highlight goals
- → Be organized and timely
  - Transcripts and letters of recommendation take time
  - Ask questions
  - Proofread!
- Submit a complete on time application



#### TIPS:

- Make the application flow easily
- Reviewers rely on the application form itself, reference points throughout your application
- Personalize letters and personal statement to each scholarship

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Undergraduate or graduate students who are U.S. citizens and reside and/or attend school in Northern California
- Demonstrated intent to pursue a career in transportation
- Commitment to improving the local community
- → Grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or above

#### **Application Period**

- → Opens in early September, closes in mid to late October (2025 Scholarships closed on 10/17)
- Scholarships awarded at annual gala in early December (2025 Gala is on December 5th)

#### 2025 Application Materials and Scoring

- Completed Application Form (10%)
- → Career Interest Essay (25%)
- → Challenge-Solution Scenario (25%)
- Financial Need Statement (15%)
- → GPA & Transcript (10%)
- → Resume (5%)
- → Two Reference Letters (10%)

Application requirements and materials may change each year, so read the entire application closely!

#### What We're Looking For

- → Demonstrated path toward a career in the transportation industry
- Involvement in community activities and organizations, including COMTO
- → Clear demonstration of financial need

#### **IMPORTANT TIPS FOR ESSAYS**

- → BE CLEAR
  - Answer the entire question
  - Provide specific details
    - Example: "I was involved in COMTO..." vs. "I served as Scholarships Co-Chair for COMTO for three years..."

#### → BE CONCISE

- Use fewer words to meet word count
  - Example: "I came to the realization that..." vs. "I realized..." (saves 4 words)

#### → BE COMPELLING

- Use personal anecdotes and experiences
  - Answer the question first, then supplement your response with enough relevant details to help you stand out

# A Professor's Perspective on Letters of Recommendation

A strong letter of recommendation begins with a strong relationship.

- Ask Early
- Be Specific
- Provide Materials
- Follow up



# **Application Tips**



- → Read instructions carefully
- → Start with your school/program
- → Be specific in essays
- → Save content for reuse
- → Track deadlines
- Request letters of recommendation early
- → Use templates
- Explore national scholarships

## O Don't

- → Go off topic
- → Exceed word count
- → Skip spell check or proofreading


