














1980s – Berlin S-Bahn & U-Bahn Separate Rail Systems in East and West Berlin




"Mushroom Concept" – Berlin S-Bahn & U-Bahn Today Integration of Rail Systems in Reunified Berlin

- Brightline is the only privately owned and operated intercity passenger railroad in the U.S.
- Current service between Miami and Orlando (235 miles)
- Boca Raton and Aventura Stations opened in 2023
- Service to Orlando commenced in 2023
- Future Expansion to Tampa
- Along existing ROW with track improvements and new stations
- Public-Private Partnership
- Ridership numbers are triple than what was expected



CUSTOMER JOURNEY: Ticketed Area Amenities










- Generous seating area with work areas



- Planned operation by 2028



Key Insights from Webinar Series for U.S. Rail

- Great stations facilitate mobility across modes and scales
- They are destinations in and of themselves
- Delivering a successful proof of concept is key
- Consistent political support, along with sufficient and stable funding are key

Relevance for the U.S.

- Convincing more Americans to ride passenger rail will require providing a highquality service.
 - It needs to be materially different than the U.S. passenger rail that they know already.
 - It must be convenient, comfortable, and it needs to connect people to the places where they want to go
- Brightline as a hopeful case study
 - Convenient, customer-centric service
 - How broadly applicable is the concept?
 - What should be expect to be the ongoing role of the public sector?



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
